The ACF is governed by a Board of between 15 and 18 members. Decisions made by the Board are reported to affiliated state associations by the relevant State Co-ordinator and to the general membership at Annual Meetings usually held at the Australian National Square Dance Convention.

Any board member may raise a matter for discussion. Such matters may be at the request of another member or state association.

The matter for discussion will be circulated to all board members.

The secretary or chairman will set a time line to limit discussion. All replies and discussion are to be sent to all other board members.

A board member will be appointed to summarize all responses and formulate a proposal or resolution for a final vote.
