

PROCEDURE FOR RE ASSESSMENT OF CONVENTION ELIGIBILITY

A Caller will be given an initial assessment when first becoming eligible for national convention programming. The need for assessment will be triggered by the membership renewal form and recognised and initiated by the State Coordinator. This assessment will be based on the eligibility guidelines as outlined by By Laws clause 12.102 - 13.110

Applications for re assessment will be brought to the full board through the State Coordinator. The Registrar will co ordinate the data collected from each board member and make relevant adjustments to the ratings.

Once the re assessment has been completed the results will be forwarded to the State Co-Ordinator.

The re assessment will be made by as many board members as possible (minimum 3) and will be limited unless the caller has and is willing to regularly travel to, and be available to call at National Conventions in as many sessions as possible.

Callers with limited exposure will be encouraged to attend more National Conventions and apply for further re assessments.

Application for re assessment can only be made every 12 months.
