Prior to the National Convention, the ACF will be presenting its regular "4-Yearly Conference". This event is aimed at bringing all our Australian Callers together, along with many callers visiting from overseas. This regular Conference initially began many years ago as a means by which callers could come together for a few days of educational opportunities, social interaction and just plain fun.

In 2020 our conference will be held from Monday April 6th, through to Wednesday April 8th, at The Fairmont Resort in the town of Leura, in the heart of the Blue Mountains. There are a number of special features for this Conference including a special dance featuring our general membership on Sunday April 5th, and finishing with a special dance with our overseas guest caller Randy Dougherty on Thursday April 9th.

To enhance the educational opportunities available for attendees, we will also have a very special guest on staff. A professional Voice Coach, who will present us with information to assist, enhance and improve our vocal techniques.

The Feature Presenter


RANDY DOUGHERTY


Randy began dancing at age nine, but a football injury (broken leg) at age 15 created a boring six-month lay-up. During this time, he was inspired to give calling a try. He attended the 1967 Central Iowa Callers' Clinic in Des Moines, Iowa. In 1972, Randy took a teaching position at Fridley Grace High School. During his summer breaks, he found himself traveling farther and farther from home. In 1979, he left his teaching position to devote full time to his professional calling career. From 1979 to 1986, he called on a regular basis for seven home clubs in the Twin Cities (Minneapolis–Saint Paul, Minnesota) area and broadened his traveling circuit to include much of the United States and many foreign countries. In 1986, Randy left Minnesota for the warmer climate of Arizona.

Currently, Randy runs a busy dance program in Texas during the winter season. In the summer he tours the United States and books many foreign calling trips; recently including such countries as Canada, Mexico, Sweden, Denmark, Netherlands, Japan, Saudi Arabia, England, Germany, Australia and New Zealand.

To date, he has attended, and called for, nearly 40 National Conventions. He is an accredited Callerlab Caller Coach. He has served three terms on the Board of Governors of Callerlab, served on the Executive Committee for two years, and many instructional panels. Randy has been honored with a Special Recognition Award from Chairman Mike Seastrom for his assistance in taping all the sessions at the 1993 National Convention in order to establish the frequency count in use today. Throughout his career, Randy has recorded hits for many record companies.

The Fairmont Resort is situated in the picturesque township of Leura, just a few kilometers from Katoomba and the many attractions that this area has to offer. Just where are we heading with this?

Plans started to take shape shortly after the last conference at Mooloolabah in 2016. Lots of ideas came up, but the main concern by all involved was to present a programme that flowed from one topic to the next. We did not want just a jumble of great, but unrelated topics; rather we wanted to take a holistic approach, based on a general theme. It was felt that all callers should have the same opportunity for to attend each session presented, hence a 3 pronged approach was to be undertaken. This meant that each topic presented would be actually done 3 times, with each version aimed at a different knowledge base by the attendees. Thus we would have a specific topic for the newer callers, same topic with emphasis changed to a more experienced group and lastly a third group that would be for the callers with the most experience.


This also worked into the concept of limited numbers for the sessions with our Voice Coach, allowing each caller to have the opportunity to have individual time with the Coach

Our committee for this Conference is a relatively small one, enabling good communication and discussion. The one who has been doing most of the running around and general organization is Barry Wonson. He has had numerous meetings with the management at the Fairmont as well as many others in the area.

The programme is in the hands of Steve Turner and Barry Wonson. They are continually adjusting the blueprint as new ideas and suggestions are made.

Normally, on the last night of the conference all attendees get together at a banquet. Although this has not been mentioned earlier; we **WILL** be having a banquet on the Wednesday Evening. REGISTRATION: At the end of this newsletter you will find a registration form for the Conference along with an accommodation booking form for the Fairmont Resort.

ACCOMMODATION is to be booked directly with the Fairmont Resort. They have given us a very good rate for the callers attending the conference. Current rates are actually more than those quoted us for 2020. **BOOK EARLY** – it is important to remember that this area is one of the most visited in NSW. During Easter the most accommodations, including the Fairmont run at 100% occupancy. **It would be advisable to register and book accommodation as early as possible.**

The 61st National Square Dance Convention will follow the ACF Conference. The venue is Blue Mountains Grammar School at Wentworth Falls; the next village south from Leura...about 6 minutes away.


PRESENTERS: Our feature Presenter is Randy Dougherty, however we will have other presenters. Our current plan is for at least two other presenters / callers offering insights, ideas, and guidance within the framework of specific topics requested by callers.

PROGRAM: At the moment we have a basic outline of all the sessions for the conference. Although not all sessions have been fully defined as yet; it is hoped that we will have further details for everyone within the very short term, following the National Convention in Perth. We will update all the information on a regular basis.

VOCAL COACH: A vocal coach was first used back in 1981 at CALLERLAB. The coach featured was Arden Hopkin, who became a regular contributor to CALLERLAB's line-up of sessions until his retirement a few years ago. The tapes from these sessions are in our library and are available for our ACF members to listen to at any time. Arden's presentations are the base for what we are aiming for in 2020 – an introductory session followed by a series of sessions with small groups in order for each attendee to have mic time. We believe that these sessions will be something really special for all attendees.

COST: We have attempted to keep our costs as low as possible in order for all to be able to attend. The ACF is subsidizing all attending by a very large amount as the actual costs involved are more than double the amount given for each caller.

Puttin' on the Ritz

Relive the glamour of the 1920's at Australia's first tourist destination
